In keeping with our mission of building community and providing support for the continuing education of men, women, and high school seniors (Class of '20) the ACCF and WIB scholarship committee will award scholarships of up to \$1000.

Application Deadline is September 12, 2019

Eligibility and Application Requirements

- Applicant must be a resident of Ahwatukee or a Chamber Member business and continuing their education
- Work, reside or attend school in the Ahwatukee Foothills community/Ahwatukee Chamber member
- Be a legal United States resident
- Complete each area of the Application Form, including signature
- Submit all forms to the Ahwatukee Foothills Chamber of Commerce office by September 12, 2019
- Finalists will be required to participate in a personal interview with the selection committee in late September or early October, 2019

Your application must include:

This signed application form and official transcripts (High School seniors).

A resume of business, academic and community involvement (two page maximum):

List your business, academic and community activities that will give the committee an understanding of your connection to the Ahwatukee Foothills community. Including, but not limited to, employment, clubs, organizations, community projects, awards and honors and leadership positions.

An essay of your business experience (300 to 500 words):

An essay of 500 words or less that clearly describes your academic and/or professional goals, the relevance of your major to the business field, and how the Chamber Foundation Scholarship will assist you in reaching your goals.

Two letters of recommendation (one page maximum):

One letter should be from a supervisor or leader in reference to work or volunteer experience (paid, volunteer or charity work). The second letter should be personal character reference offering a perspective on your life, what you excel in, and how you overcome challenges.

A personal essay including financial need (300 to 500 words):

Submit a personal essay that details why you should be awarded this scholarship. Include information about how you plan to use the award, if awarded.

4) Written essay:

Submit a personal essay that details why you should be awarded this scholarship. Include information about how you plan to use the award, if awarded.
